

**Topic: Strengthening the Coordination of the United Nation's Emergency Humanitarian Assistance**

1 ACKNOWLEDGING that in past instances involving crisis issues and response, several  
2 unsatisfactory problems emerged in the form of unacceptable and tragic death due to  
3 overly delayed response time,  
4

5 SUGGESTING alternative methods concerning the immediate crisis protocol that could  
6 be streamlined for maximum efficiency pertaining to quick reaction time and  
7 effectiveness of the provided humanitarian aid,  
8

9 REAFFIRMING that humanitarian aid should never be given to nations unwilling to  
10 receive it, in the interest of preserving national sovereignty,  
11

12 RECALLING actions of the Humanitarian Aid Council that convened a review board on  
13 “humanitarian aid”,  
14

- 15 1. RECOMMENDS the convening of a conference to perform a comprehensive  
16 analysis and evaluation of the actions taken by the Office for the Coordination of  
17 Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA), current non-governmental organizations and  
18 private sectors in Humanitarian Aid, and crisis response processes in the hopes of  
19 streamlining current practices in order to promote efficiency and to further deter  
20 response delaying actions,
  - 21 a. That an initiative to streamline OCHA toward specialized crises response,  
22 focused upon well informed fast reaction to crises,
  - 23 b. That this specific conference will draw upon private consulting  
24 environmental, medical, and social organizations within member states to  
25 immediately analyze and evaluate how best to provide assistance to  
26 countries in need;

28 2. PROVIDING forms of humanitarian aid other than monetary funds, specifically  
29 personnel,
  - 30 a. That such personnel will initially distribute aid-rendering services,
  - 31 b. As a long-term solution, the same personnel would train indigenous  
32 people in performing the same aid-rendering services in the case of future  
33 incidents that would necessitate humanitarian aid,
  - 34 c. This conference would consider all forms of humanitarian crises under its  
35 purview, including, but not limited to, natural disasters and conflict areas  
36 which result in the inevitable swell of displaced persons and refugees;
